APPEARANCES IN THE AP CURRICULUM

- New belief systems and cultural traditions emerged and spread, often asserting universal truths (**Christianity, Greco-Roman philosophy**)
- Literature and drama* (**Greek Plays, Indian Epics**) acquired distinctive forms that influenced artistic developments in neighboring regions and in later time periods.
- Distinctive architectural styles* developed in many regions in this period (**Roman Empire**)
- The **convergence of Greco-Roman culture and Buddhist beliefs** affected the development of unique sculptural developments.
- The number and size of **key states and empires** grew dramatically by imposing political unity on areas where previously there had been competing states. (**Classical Mediterranean: Phoenician, Greek, Roman**)
- In order to organize their subjects, the rulers created *administrative institutions in many regions* (**Rome**)
- Imperial governments projected military power over larger areas *using a variety of techniques*
- Much of the success of the empires rested on their promotion of trade economic integration by building and maintaining roads and issuing currencies
- Cities served as centers of trade, public performance of religious rituals, & political administrations for states/empires (Carthage, Rome, Athens, Constantinople, Alexandria)
- The social structures of empires displayed hierarchies that included cultivators, laborers, slaves, artisans, merchants, elites, or caste groups.
- Imperial societies relied on a *range of methods* (**Corvee, Slavery, Rents and tributes, Peasant communities, Family and household production**) to maintain the production of food and provide rewards for the loyalty of the elites.
- The Roman Empire created political, cultural, and administrative difficulties that they could not manage, which eventually led to their decline, collapse, and transformation into successor empires or states.
- Through excessive mobilization of resources, imperial governments caused *environmental damage*
- External problems* resulted from security issues *along their frontiers*
- The *spread of disease pathogens* diminished urban populations and contributed to the decline of some empires

WHAT IS PHOENICIA?

- PHOENICIA (1200 BCE-539 BCE) WAS A **THALASSOCRACY** (SUCH A GOOD WORD...)
- STATE WITH PRIMARILY MARITIME LANDS/REALMS
- SEE THE MAP ABOVE
- PH WAS A TRADING EMPIRE LOCATED AROUND THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA
- PH LITERALLY MEANS, "LAND OF PURPLE" IN GREEK
- DUE TO THEIR MONOPOLY ON THE TYRIAN PURPLE DYE (FROM EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN SEA SNAIL MUCOUS)
- PURPLE-DYED CLOTH WAS WORTH ITS WEIGHT IN SILVER
- NEVER FADED; BECAME BRIGHTER IN THE SUN

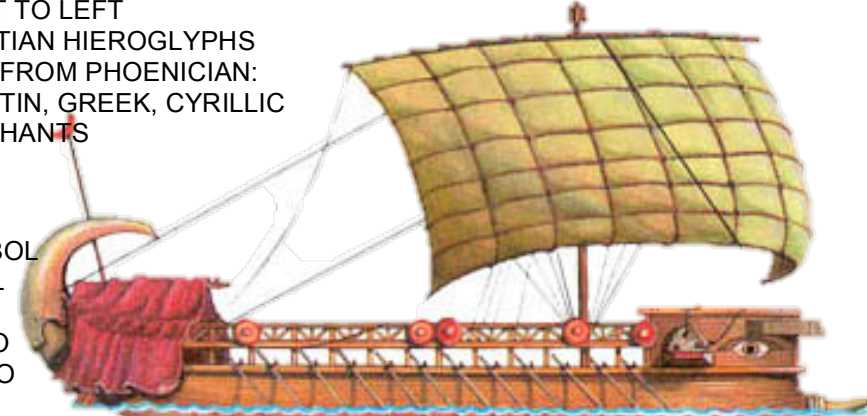

CLASSICAL GREECE

ATHENS

- ATHENS DATES BACK TO NEOLITHIC
- LET'S START WITH **SOLOON**
 - REFORMED THE MONARCHY SYSTEM IN PLACE IN c. 600 BCE
 - ESTABLISHED ATH. DEMOCRACY
 - GAVE VOTING RIGHTS TO ALL (FREE) ATHENIANS
- CLASSICAL ATHENS (508-322 BCE)
 - **PERSIAN WARS** (499-449 BCE)
 - ATHENS AIDED THE IONIANS IN THEIR REVOLT AGAINST THE PERSIANS (ACHAEMENID)
 - LED TO PERSIAN INVASIONS OF MAINLAND GREECE
 - 1ST: ATHENS DEFEATS DARIUS AT MARATHON
 - 2ND: GREEKS DEFEAT XERXES; DOESN'T RETURN



DELIAN LEAGUE

- ATHENIAN-LED ALLIANCE OF GREEK CITY-STATES
- ALL STATES THAT HAD DEFEATED THE PERSIANS
- ATHENIAN DOMINANCE LED TO RESENTMENT
- **PELOPONNESIAN WARS**
 - ATHENS VS. SPARTA
 - SPARTA WINS, BUT...
 - THE MACEDONIANS INVADE...

SPARTA

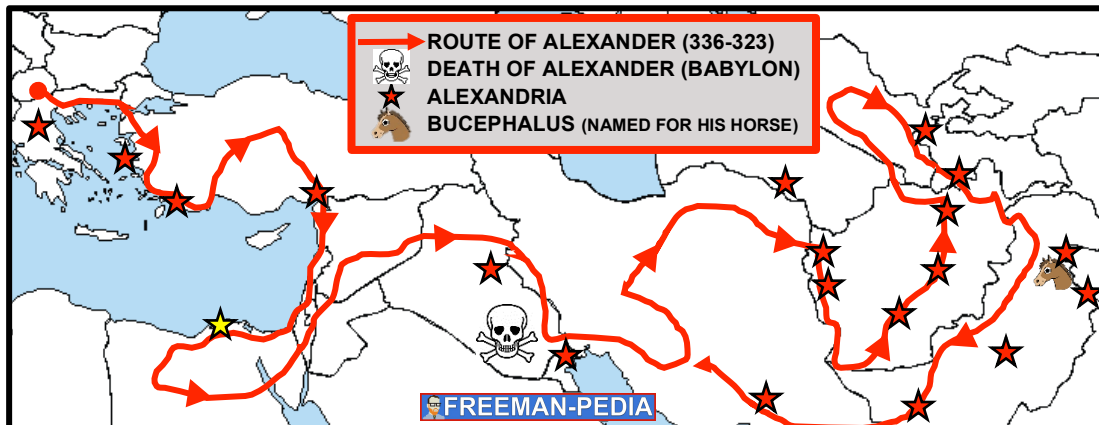
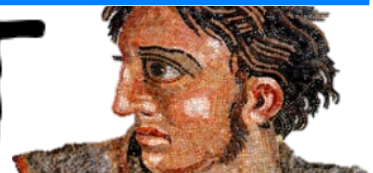
- ATHENS WAS GREECE'S GREATEST NAVAL POWER
- SPARTA WAS GREECE'S GREATEST LAND POWER
- SPARTA LED THE DEFENSE AT THE BATTLE OF THERMOPYLAE (300) AND EVENTUALLY CHASED THE PERSIANS OUT OF GREECE FOREVER (PLATAEA)
 - SPARTA EVEN WON THE PELOPONNESIAN WAR AGAINST ATHENS
 - ULTIMATELY LOST TO THE MACEDONIANS



SPARTAN LIFE

- LYCURGUS INSTILLED REFORMS TO CREATE A MILITARISTIC STATE AFTER CONSULTING THE ORACLE
- AFTER BIRTH, BABIES WERE JUDGED
 - IF "PUNY"; TOSSED INTO THE CHASM
- AGE 7: BOYS MOVE INTO COMMUNAL SCHOOL
 - INTENTIONALLY UNDERFED TO IMITATE BATTLE
- AGE 20: JOIN THE SPARTAN ARMY
- AGE 30: PERMITTED TO MARRY & BECOME CITIZEN
- AGE 60: MEN LEAVE THE ACTIVE RESERVE

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

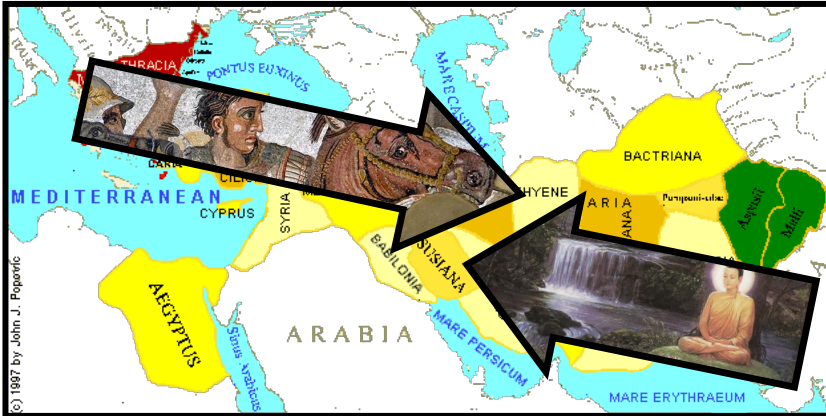


- **FATHER=KING PHILLIP II OF MACEDONIA**
 - USED THE PELOPONNESIAN WAR TO INVADE AND CONQUER MUCH OF GREECE BEFORE HIS ASSASSINATION IN 336 BCE
- ALEXANDER CAME TO POWER AT AGE 20
 - TUTORED BY PHILOSOPHER ARISTOTLE
 - QUICKLY TOOK CONTROL OF MASSIVE ARMY
 - **PERSIA**: TOOK 10 YEARS; ENDED THE ACHAEMENID EMPIRE
 - IDOLIZED CYRUS & KEPT MANY PERSIAN TRADITIONS
 - **EGYPT**: SPARED JERUSALEM; CONQUERED EGYPT
 - GREETED AS LIBERATOR; CROWNED PHAROAH
 - **INDIA**: CONTINUED CONQUERING PAST THE INDUS RIVER
- MUTINY: TROOPS REFUSED TO GO FURTHER AT BEAS RIVER
 - DIED HAVING MADE IT BACK TO BABYLON AT 32

The convergence of Greco-Roman culture and Buddhist beliefs affected the development of unique sculptural developments.



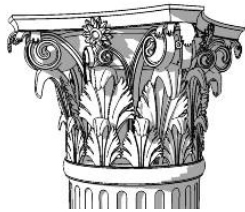
Greco-Buddhism is the name given to the **SYNCRETISM** (the combining of different (often contradictory) beliefs, often while melding practices of various schools of thought) of Hellenistic and Buddhist cultures sometime between the 4th & 5th Centuries BCE. This was most commonly seen around the Indian Subcontinent (from Afghanistan through India). It's influences eventually spread as far east as Japan (Japan developed a Hercules-god that defended the Buddha known as Nio).

It began with Alexander the Great's incursion into the India Subcontinent. It was carried on after Alexander by the Indo-Greek rulers during the Hellenistic Era. It had profound influence on the development of Buddhism (particularly Mahayana Buddhism).

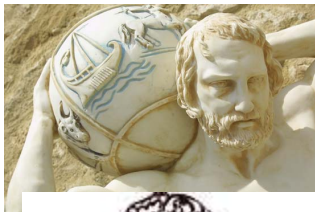

The latest of the three orders of Greco-Roman architecture, Corinthian columns derive their name from Corinth.



Atlas was a Greek Titan who held up the celestial spheres (although today he is often depicted holding up the earth).



Toga was the distinctive Roman garment worn over a tunic. It was made of wool and only worn by Roman (male) citizens.

Typical Buddhist relief on a wall in India. Notice how he is prominently featured in the new Greco-Buddhist column.



Typical base of a statue of Buddha from India. Buddha is often seen sitting beneath the Bodhi tree.



There are no statue representations of Buddha pre-1st Century CE. Other statues show humans in loin cloths.

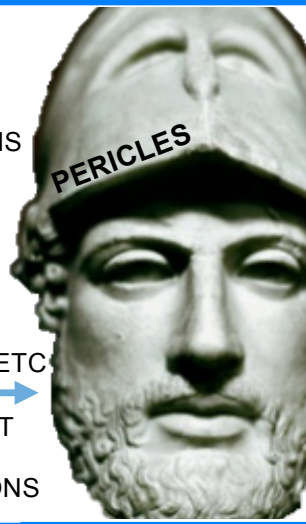

GREEK FOR "OF OR RELATING TO THE CITIZENS"

- WHEN YOU THINK OF ATHENS, YOU'RE THINKING OF ATHENS DURING THE AGE OF PERICLES
- GOLDEN AGE OF ATHENS** (480-404 BCE)
 - END OF PERSIAN WARS → PELOPONNESIAN WARS
 - EARTH'S FIRST DEMOCRACY (DIRECT DEMOCRACY)
 - PARTICIPATING CITIZENS VOTED ON LEGISLATION
 - ADULT-MALES WHO COMPLETED MILITARY TRAINING
 - 50K/300K (17%); REST WERE WOMEN, KIDS, SLAVES, ETC.
 - LONGEST LASTING RULER → PERICLES
 - EQUAL SPEECH IN ASSEMBLY, PUBLIC OFFICES BY LOT
- CRITICS (INCLUDING THUCYDIDES, PLATO, ARISTOTLE)
- FOUND COMMON PEOPLE DIDN'T MAKE THE BEST DECISIONS



GREEK FOR "A PLACE FOR VIEWING" THEATRE

- EARLIEST KNOWN ACTOR: **THESPI**
 - WINNER OF 1ST THEATRICAL CONTEST IN ATHENS (532 BCE)
- ORIGINATED FROM HYMNS SANG TO DIONYSUS (WINE)
 - ORIGINALLY WRITTEN FOR DIONYSUS & PERFORMED ONLY ONCE
 - BECAME MORE FORMALIZED AFTER THEATRE REBUILT AFTER PERSIANS LEFT
 - STARTED WITH JUST ONE ACTOR
 - LATER AS MANY AS 3
 - OFTEN IN MASKS
- TWO GENRES:**
 - TRAGEDIES
 - COMEDY



HISTORY

GREEK FOR "INQUIRY, KNOWLEDGE ACQUIRED BY INVESTIGATION"

- EARLIEST KNOWN SYSTEMATIC HISTORICAL THOUGHT EMERGED IN GREECE
- HERODOTUS** (484-425 BCE)
 - "FATHER OF HISTORY"
 - COVERED THE PERSIAN WARS
 - LIVED IN PERICLES' ATHENS
 - OFTEN INCLUDED THE GODS, SUPERNATURAL
 - DIFFERENTIATED BETWEEN WHAT HE SAW/WHAT HE WAS TOLD
- THUCYDIDES** (460-400 BCE)
 - ATHENIAN HISTORIAN
 - WROTE ON PELOPONNESIAN WAR
 - "SCIENTIFIC HISTORY": NO GODS

GREEK FOR "CHIEF BUILDER" (ARCHITECT)

- EXAMPLES OF GREEK ARCHITECTURE:
 - TEMPLES, THEATRES, COLUMNS, MAUSOLEUMS, STADIUMS, STATUES, ETC.
- ALL MEANT TO LOOK LIKE THEY ARE SCULPTURES THEMSELVES!
 - OFTEN ON A RAISED PLATFORM
 - STYLISTICALLY DIVIDED INTO **3 ORDERS**
 - EACH NAMED FOR THE REGION FROM WHICH THEY ORIGINATED
- HUGE IMPACT ON WESTERN ARCHITECTURE



 SOCRATES, PLATO, & ARISTOTLE

- GREEK PHILOSOPHY IS DIVIDED INTO THREE GROUPS:
 - 1. PRE-SOCRATICS**
 - ALL PHILOSOPHERS PRIOR TO SOCRATES
 - MVP: *ANAXIMANDER* (1ST TO WRITE DOWN IDEAS)
 - 2. SOCRATICS** →
 - ALL RECORDED BY PLATO
 - SOCRATIC METHOD
 - 3. POST-SOCRATICS**
 - MVP: *MARCUS AURELIUS* (PHILOSOPHER/EMPEROR)
- ATHENIANS (*SURPRISE, SURPRISE*)
- SOCRATES, PLATO, ARISTOTLE
 - "SOCRATES WAS THE 1ST WHO BROUGHT PHILOSOPHY DOWN FROM THE HEAVENS"-CICERO
 - SOCRATES WROTE NOTHING DOWN
 - ALL RECORDED BY PLATO
 - SOCRATES KILLED FOR CORRUPTING THE YOUTH & IMPIETY (*LACK OF RESPECT FOR THE GODS*)

WHAT IS ROME?



- MARS (WAR) & RHEA SILVIA HAD TWINS
- **ROMULUS & REMUS**
- RHEA SILVIA'S BROTHER TOOK THE THRONE & ORDERED THE TWINS KILLED
- SERVANT SHOWED MERCY & SET THEM ADRIFT ON THE TIBER RIVER



- THEY WERE FOUND BY LUPA (WOLF)
- SHE RECENTLY LOST HER CUBS
- RAISED THE TWINS
- BROTHERS THEN BUILT ROME
- ROMULUS KILLED REMUS (ARGUMENT)
- NAMED THE CITY AFTER HIMSELF
- CHANCE OF THIS BEING TRUE: 0.0%

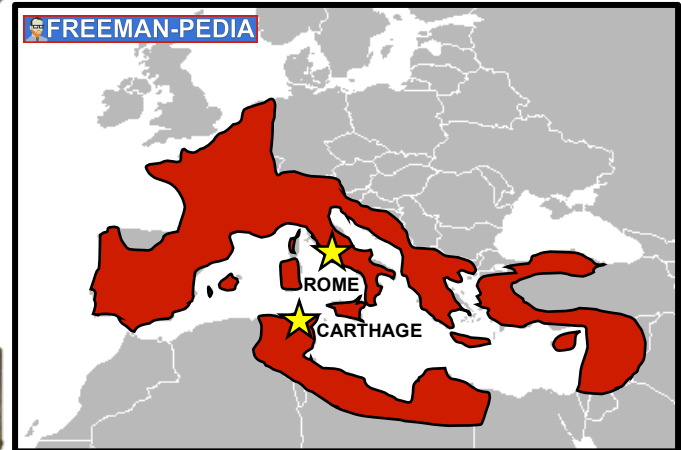
ROMAN REPUBLIC

- AFTER REMUS'S FRATRICIDE, ROME WENT THROUGH SEVERAL FORMS OF GOVERNMENT
 - CITY-STATE, MONARCHY, TYRANNY, ETC
- ROME TURNED TO A REPUBLIC AFTER OVERTHROWING THE MONARCHY AROUND 500 BCE
- ROME WAS IN A NEARLY CONSTANT STATE OF EXPANSION (BOTH ALLIANCES & WARFARE)
 - SABINES, ETRUSCANS, OSCANS, UMBRIANS, ETC.
- 12 TABLES →
 - FIRST WRITTEN ROMAN LAW CODE
 - CODIFIED=451 BCE
 - ESTABLISHED BASIC PROCEDURAL RIGHTS FOR ALL ROMAN CITIZENS
 - SENT EMBASSY TO GREECE TO STUDY THE SOLONIAN CONSTITUTION
 - NO LONGER IN EXISTENCE
 - DESTROYED BY GAULS IN 387 BCE

THE SENATE & PEOPLE OF ROME



PATRICIANS

- GROUP OF RULING CLASS FAMILIES IN REPUBLIC
- DESCENDENTS OF FIRST 100 SENATORS
- BELIEVED TO BETTER COMMUNICATE WITH GODS
- MORE POLITICAL RIGHTS

PLEBEIANS

- ALL FREE CITIZENS WHO WERE NOT PATRICIANS
- AKA **PLEBS**
- BANNED FROM MOST POL./REL. OFFICES
- MAY HAVE BEEN

"CONFLICT OF THE ORDERS"

- 494-287 BCE: POLITICAL STRUGGLE WHERE PLEBS SOUGHT RIGHTS
- PLEBS THREATENED SECESSION (THEY WERE THE MAJORITY)
- LAWS MANDATING PATRICIAN-ONLY ELECTIONS WERE REVOKED
- ENDS IN 287 BCE WITH PATRICIANS & PLEBS HAVING EQUAL RIGHTS

STRUCTURE OF THE ROMAN REPUBLIC

PATRICIANS



CONSULS

- HIGHEST ELECTED POLITICAL OFFICE IN THE ROMAN REPUBLIC
- EACH YEAR, TWO CONSULS WERE ELECTED TOGETHER
- ALTERNATED POWER EACH MONTH
- TOOK OVER FOR KINGS
- CHIEF EXECUTIVE POWER OF ROME



PRAETORS

- CREATED IN 367 BCE TO TAKE OVER SOME DUTIES FROM THE CONSULS
- FUN FACT: FIRST PRAETOR'S NAME WAS SPURIUS FURIUS... AWESOME.
- INITIALLY 2 (LATER, 4, 8, 12, 16)
- SERVED AS FINAL JUDGES
- HELD POWER WHEN CONSULS WERE AT WAR

PLEBEIANS

AEDILES

- PLEBS & PATRICIANS
- MAINLY PLEB
- INITIALLY ADVISORS TO THE TRIBUNES
- TOOK "CARE" OF CITY BUILDINGS, SEWERS, GRAIN



TRIBUNES



- TRIBUNE OF PLEBS WERE 10 MEN WHO SERVED AS A CHECK ON THE SENATE. PASSED LAWS THAT AFFECTED PLEBS. COULD VETO SENATE LAWS THAT AFFECTED THE PLEBS.

THE SENATE

LASTING THE ENTIRE EXPANSE OF ROMAN HISTORY (753 BCE-476 CE), IT INITIALLY SERVED AS A WEAK ADVISORY COUNCIL, BEFORE GAINING POWER OVER THE EXECUTIVES (ABOVE) DURING THE MIDDLE REPUBLIC. THE SENATE AGAIN BECAME WEAK AFTER REFORMS AND FELL BACK TO ITS ADVISORY ROLL DURING THE ROMAN EMPIRE. COMPRISED OF 300 MALE CITIZENS WHO SERVED FOR LIFE.

- CARTHAGE EVACUATED SICILY 241 BCE

2ND PUNIC WAR

- ROME CALLED IT THE "WAR AGAINST HANNIBAL"
- BEGAN AS A DISPUTE OVER WHO CONTROLLED SAGANTUM (MAP)
- HANNIBAL SACKED THE CITY
- HANNIBAL INVADED ROME
- SURPRISE THROUGH THE ALPS
- IBERIAN TROOPS & 40 ELEPHANTS
- LOST HIS SIEGE WEAPONS (& ELEPHANTS IN THE ALPS)
- COULD NOT TAKE ROME
- SURVIVED FOR 15 YRS
- ROME CUT OFF HAN.
- HAN RETURNED BUT LOST (ZAMA)

- MUCH SMALLER THAN 1, 2

 - SISTERS: (EXIST, BUT ARE NEVER NAMED)

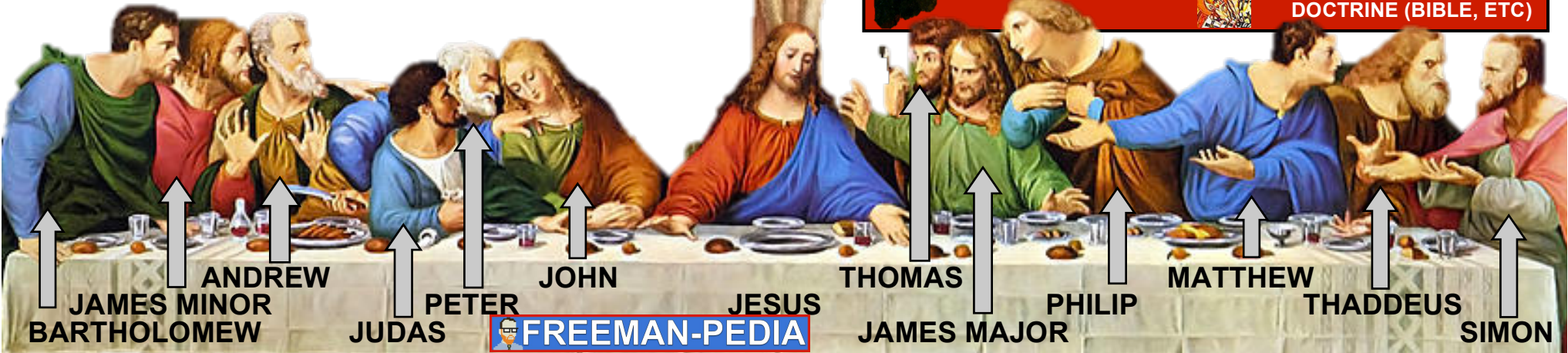

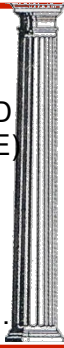

MEDICINE

- MIXTURE OF MEDICAL PRACTICES FROM AROUND THE EMPIRE (ESP. GREECE)
- BASED ON NATURAL REMEDIES RATHER THAN SPIRITUAL MEANS
- **GALEN** (129-216)-TOP PHYSICIAN UNTIL 17TH CEN.



EDUCATION

- DONE WITHIN THE FAMILIES 1ST
- EVENTUALLY, LED TO A TUITION BASED SYSTEM
- SPREAD THROUGHOUT EMP.
- BASED ON GREEK EDUCAT.
- NO PUBLIC EDUCATION
- STUDENTS PROGRESSED BASED ON ABILITY (*INGENIUM*)



WINE

- 'DAILY NECESSITY'
- SPREAD ALL OVER EMPIRE
- TECHNIQUES STILL USED TO THIS DAY



PUBLIC ORDER

- ROMAN LAW LASTED IN EUROPE UNTIL 18TH CENTURY
- 12 TABLES (449 BCE)
 - SEE ABOVE
- CONCEPTS LIKE, CITIZENSHIP, COMMON LAW, PUBLIC v. PRIVATE LAW, ETC.
- (LATIN STILL USED FOR MANY LEGAL TERMS TODAY)



IRRIGATION

- 70-90% OF ROMANS WERE INVOLVED IN AGRICULT.
- CONSISTED OF DITCHES BUILT TO DISPERSE H2O
- FARMS OFTEN BUILT ON INCLINE TO AID IRRIGAT.
- *IF AVAILABLE*, COULD PURCHASE ACCESS TO THE AQUEDUCT SYSTEM



ROADS

- STONE PAVED
- CURVED FOR DRAINAGE
- PARALLELED BY WALKING PATHS
- 372 ROADS
- 400,000 km
- LARGEST EVER

FRESH WATER

- BUILT CENTRALIZED WATER DISTRIBUTION CENTERS
- BASED ON AQUEDUCTS
- H2O CAME INTO TOWN AND WAS DISTRIBUTED TO DIFFERENT AREAS
- FOUNTAINS RANS 24/7



PUBLIC HEALTH

- BATHS, SEWERS, AND AQUEDUCTS GREATLY INCREASED PUBLIC HEALTH
- HOSPITALS BUILT
 - MAINLY FOR SOLDIERS
- DIET WAS INCREDIBLY IMPT.
- PERFORMED SURGERIES
- DRAINED SWAMPS
 - REDUCED MALARIA



PEACE

- 'PAX ROMANA'
- 27 BCE-180 CE
- RELATIVE ERA OF PEACE

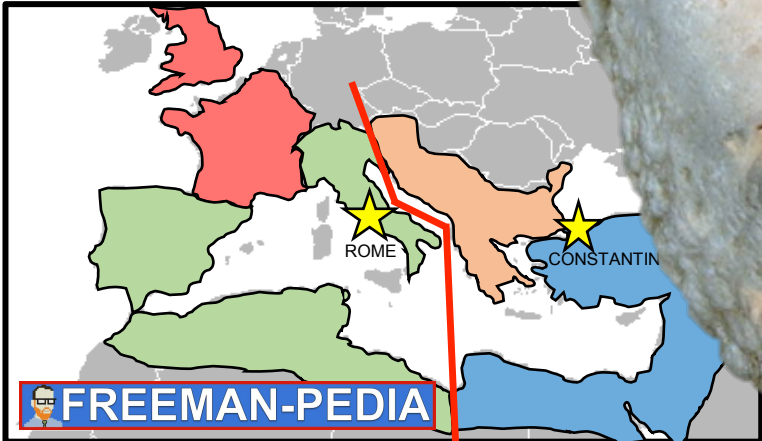

- ### DIOCLETIAN 244-311
- DEFEATED CARINUS (SEE ABOVE)
 - EMPIRE WAS TOO LARGE TO BE RULED CENTRALLY
 - DIVIDED ROME INTO FOUR DIVISIONS (*TETRARCHY*)
 - CREATED CO-EMPERORS (*AUGUSTUS*) WITH SUB-EMPERORS (*CAESARS*)
 - DEFEATED THE SASSANIDS (PERSIA)
 - REFORMS:
 - DIVIDED EMPIRE (4 CAPITALS)
 - COMPREHENSIVE TAX REFORM
 - HARSHTEST CHRISTIAN PERSECUTOR
 - 1ST EMPEROR TO RETIRE IN 305 CE



- ### CONSTANTINE 272-337
- CONSTANTINE'S DAD ROSE TO THE RANK OF *AUGUSTUS* IN THE WEST
 - FATHER DIED IN 306 CE
 - LED TO CIVIL WAR THAT ENDED IN 324 WITH CONSTANTINE RULING THE ENTIRE EMPIRE (UNTIL DEATH IN 337)
 - ACCOMPLISHMENTS:
 - ENDED DIO'S TETRARCHY
 - MOVED CAPITAL TO BYZANTIUM
 - CREATED NEW COIN (STANDARD I BYZ & EUR FOR 1,000 YEARS)
 - CHRISTIANITY:
 - DEATHBED CONVERSION
 - LEGALIZES CHRISTIANITY (E. of M)
 - CALLED 1ST COUNCIL OF NICEA
 - BUILT CHURCH OF HOLY SEPULCHUR

- TOOK 100+ YEARS

THE PEAK

- ROME REACHED ITS PHYSICAL PEAK IN 117
 - TRAJAN (2ND GOOD EMPEROR)
- MILITARY
 - MASSIVE MILITARY (400,000+ AT ITS PEAK)
 - US ARMY ACTIVE TODAY=475,000
- EMPIRE
 - CITY OF ROME HAD OVER 1 MILLION PEOPLE
 - NOT MATCHED IN EUROPE UNTIL THE 1800s
 - 400,000km of ROADS
 - FROM SCOTLAND TO THE PERSIAN GULF
- ECONOMY
 - COLLECTED TAXES, SUPPORTED ARMY
 - MASSIVE TRADE NETWORK (INDIA, CHINA)
- LEADERSHIP
 - ABOUT 100 YEARS OF SOLID LEADERSHIP

CRISES OF THE 3RD CENTURY MILITARY

- ROME OFFICIALLY FELL IN 476
- BUT, SHE ALMOST FELL IN THE 200s (*SEE PREVIOUS PAGE*)
- ROME ACTUALLY DIVIDED INTO THREE COMPETING STATES:
 - GAUL, PALMYRENE, & ROME
- SASSANID PERSIANS DEFEATED THE ROMANS THRICE! (3x)
- CYPRIAN PLAGUE KILLED 5,000 PEOPLE A DAY (SMALLPOX)
- BARBARIAN RAIDS/INVASIONS
 - CARPIANS, GOTHs, VANDALS

- TO DEFEND THE EMPIRE, RECRUITED FROM THE BARBARIANS
- LACK OF RESOURCES STEMMED FROM POLITICAL CORRUPTION
 - MONEY TAKEN BY OFFICIALS NEVER REACHED THE MILITARY
- CHUNKS OF THE EMPIRE BEGAN FALLING TO INVADERS:
 - ENGLAND, FRANCE, AFRICA

EMPERORS BARBARIANS!

- NOT EXACTLY THE VARSITY SQUAD (*SEE PREVIOUS PAGE*)
- AFTER 270, TOOK TITLE OF LORD & GOD (*DOMINUS, DEUS*)
- CORRUPTION, ASSASSINATION
- POWER STRUGGLES LED TO DEVASTATING CIVIL WARS

- ALWAYS A PROBLEM FOR THE EMPIRE, BUT STARTING IN 376; LARGE NUMBERS OF BARBARIANS FLEEING THE HUNS BEGAN POURING INTO ROMAN TERRITORY
- ALARIC (KING OF VISIGOTHS) SACKED ROME 3x IN 400s & TOOK CONTROL OF THE BALKANS (1ST TIME IN 800 YRS)

ECONOMY FALL OF ROME

- HUGE INCOME INEQUALITY
- RICHEST FAMILIES BECAME IMMUNE TO TAXATION
- UNEMPLOYMENT GREW
- LARGE ESTATES (LATIFUNDIA) PUT SMALL FARMERS OUT OF BUSINESS

- IN 476, ODOACER DEPOSED THE LAST ROMAN EMPEROR (ROMULUS AUGUSTULUS) AND TOOK CONTROL OF ITALIA
