APPEARANCES IN THE AP CURRICULUM

- New belief systems and cultural traditions emerged and spread, often asserting universal truths (Christianity, Greco-Roman philosophy)
- Literature and drama (Greek Plays, Indian Epics) acquired distinctive forms that influenced artistic developments in neighboring regions and in later time periods.
- Distinctive architectural styles developed in many regions in this period (Roman Empire)
- The convergence of Greco-Roman culture and Buddhist beliefs affected the development of unique sculptural developments.
- The number and size of key states and empires grew dramatically by imposing political unity on areas where previously there had been competing states. (Classical Mediterranean:

Phoenician, Greek, Roman) In order to organize their subjects, the rulers created administrative institutions in many

- regions (Rome)
- Imperial governments projected military power over larger areas using a variety of techniques
- Much of the success of the empires rested on their promotion of trade economic integration by building and maintaining roads and issuing currencies
- Cities served as centers of trade, public performance of religious rituals, & political administrations for states/empires (Carthage, Rome, Athens, Constantinople, Alexandria)
- The social structures of empires displayed hierarchies that included cultivators, laborers, slaves, artisans, merchants, elites, or caste groups.
- Imperial societies relied on a range of methods (Corvee, Slavery, Rents and tributes, Peasant communities, Family and household production) to maintain the production of food and provide rewards for the loyalty of the elites.
- The Roman Empire created political, cultural, and administrative difficulties that they could not manage, which eventually led to their decline, collapse, and transformation into successo empires or states.
- Through excessive mobilization of resources, imperial governments caused environmental
- External problems resulted from security issues along their frontiers
- The spread of disease pathogens diminished urban populations and contributed to the decline

GRECO-BUDDHSM The convergence of Greco-Roman culture and Buddhist beliefs affected the development

of unique sculptural developments.



Greco-Buddhism is the name given to the SYNCRETISM (the combining of different (often contradictory) beliefs, often while melding practices of various schools of thought) of Hellenistic and Buddhist cultures sometime between the 4th & 5th Centuries BCE. This was most commonly seen around the Indian Subcontinent (from Afghanistan through India). It's influences eventually spread as far east as Japan (Japan developed a Hercules-god that defended the Buddha known as Nio).

It began with Alexander the Great's incursion into the India Subcontinent. It was carried on after Alexander by the Indo-Greek rulers during the Hellenistic Era. It had profound influence on the development of Buddhism (particularly Mahayana Buddhism).



SANITATION

- COMPLEX SERIES OF SEWAGE/WASTE REMOVAL
- NO FLUSH TOILETS
- MORE OF A LATRINE THAT CARRIED WASTE AWAY
- HOUSES CONNECTED 100 CE
- (ALSO JUST CHUCKED IT OUT THE WINDOW=ILLEGAL)

MEDICINE

- MIXTURE OF MEDICAL PRACTICES FROM AROUND THE EMPIRE (ESP. GREECE)
- BASED ON NATURAL REMEDIES RATHER THAN SPIRITUAL MEANS
- GALEN (129-216)-TOP PHYSICIAN UNTIL 17TH CEN.

EDUCATION

- DONE WITHIN THE FAMILIES 1ST
- EVENTUALLY, LED TO A TUITION BASED SYSTEM
- SPREAD THROUGHOUT EMP.
- BASED ON GREEK EDUCAT.
- NO PUBLIC EDUCATION
- STUDENTS PROGRESSED BASED ON ABILITY (INGENIUM)

WINE

- 'DAILY NECESSITY'
- SPREAD ALL OVER EMPIRE
- TECHNIQUES
 STILL USED TO
 THIS DAY

PUBLIC ORDER

- ROMAN LAW LASTED IN EUROPE UNTIL 18TH CENTURY
- 12 TABLES (449 BCE)SEE ABOVE
- CONCEPTS LIKE, CITIZENSHIP, COMMON LAW, PUBLIC v. PRIVATE LAW, ETC.
- (LATIN STILL USED FOR MANY LEGAL TERMS TODAY)

TRRIGATION

- 70-90% OF ROMANS WERE INVOLVED IN AGRICULT.
- CONSISTED OF DITCHES BUILT TO DISPERSE H2O
- FARMS OFTEN BUILT ON INCLINE TO AID IRRIGAT.
- IF AVAILABLE, COULD PURCHASE ACCESS TO THE AQUEDUCT SYSTEM

ROADS

- STONE PAVED
- CURVED FOR DRAINAGE
- PARALLELED BY WALKING PATHS
- 372 ROADS
- 400.000 km
- LARGEST EVER

FRESH WATER

- BUILT CENTRALIZED WATER DISTRIBUTION CENTERS
- BASED ON AQUEDUCTS
- H2O CAME INTO TOWN AND WAS DISTRIBUTED TO DIFFERENT AREAS
- FOUNTAINS RANS 24/7

PUBLIC HEALTH

- BATHS, SEWERS, AND AQUEDUCTS GREATLY INCREASED PUBLIC HEALTH
- HOSPITALS BUILT
- MAINLY FOR SOLDIERS
- DIET WAS INCREDIBLY IMPT.
- PERFORMED SURGERIES
- DRAINED SWAMPS
- o REDUCED MALARIA

- 'PAX ROMANA'
- 27 BCE-180 CE
