APPEARANCES IN THE AP CURRICULUM:

- Existing trade routes flourished and promoted the growth of powerful *new trading cities*
 - ★ CALICUT, MALAKA
- In key places along important trade routes, merchants set up *diasporic communities*

 - Chinese merchant communities in Southeast Asia

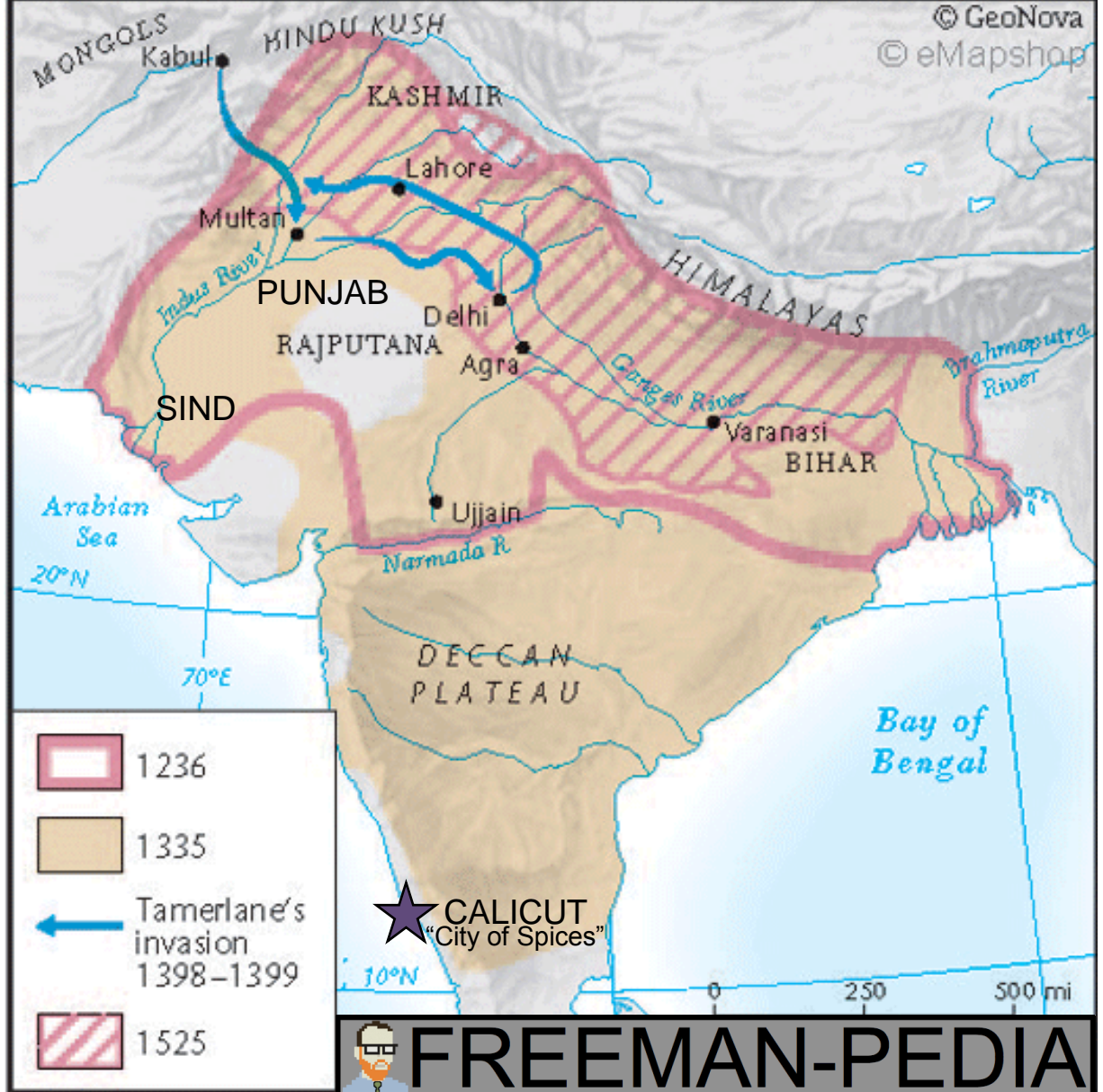


GURU NANAK

- INITIAL ARRIVAL: 711 CE
 - MUHAMMAD BIN QASIM
 - UMAYYAD GENERAL
 - CONQUERED: SINDH
- UMAYYAD v. ABBASID LEFT THEM QUASI-INDEPENDENT UNTIL

962-1186

- SECOND WAVE OF ISLAMIC ADVANCE
- EMPIRE IN OLD KUSHAN AREA (AFGH)
- SPORADICALLY INVADED/ATTACKED HINDU KINGDOMS
- RAJPUTS-ARISTOCRATIC HINDUS CONQUERED BY MoG
 - USED ELEPHANTS/INFANTRY < MoG's CAVALRY
 - RAJPUTS OFTEN FOUGHT WITH ONE ANOTHER
- MoG's EMPIRE DECLINED AFTER HIS DEATH

1206-1526

- TECHNICALLY, 5 TURKIC/AFGHAN DYNASTIES
 - MAMLUK, KHILJI, TUGHLAQ, SAYYID, LODI
 - LEFT TO RULE THEMSELVES DUE TO DISTANCE/INVASIONS FROM ARABIA
- REMEMBERED FOR TWO REASONS:
 - INVASIONS (MONGOL/TAMERLANE)
 - ERA OF INDIAN RENAISSANCE:
- INVASIONS:
 - MONGOL INVASIONS (1221-1327)
 - DELHI HELD OFF THE MONGOLS FROM MAINLAND INDIA
 - MONGOLS DID TAKE PUNJAB/PAKISTAN
 - TIMUR'S INVASIONS (SEE
 - BABUR (MUGHAL FOUNDER)
 - KABUL RULER WHO INVADED AND BEGAN THE MUGHAL EMPIRE (1526-1857)
 - ENDING THE DELHI SULTANATE
- INDIAN RENAISSANCE:
 - GREAT INDO-MUSLIM CULTURE FORMED
 - LANGUAGE: URDU
 - BLENDING OF INDIAN, PERSIAN, ARABIC, & TURKIC (TODAY=LANGUAGE OF PAKISTAN)
 - ISLAMIC RULERS ACCEPTED HINDU PRACTICES
 - HINDUS HAD TO PAY THE TAX
 - MILLIONS CONVERTED (MAINLY SUDRAH/PARIAHS)
 - TWO MOST DIFFERENT CO-EXISTING RELIGIONS
 - SYNCRETISM:
 - UPPER-CASTE HINDU MALES TOOK ON **PURDAH** (FEMALE SECLUSION)
 - SATI REMAINED THE SAME :(
 - MUSLIMS/TURKS CREATED THEIR OWN CASTES!
 - MUSLIMS SAW THEMSELVES AS FOREIGN CONQUERORS
 - LIVED SEPARATELY; ONLY MUSLIMS HAD POWER

SULTANATE (n)- LANDS IN THE SURROUNDING AREA(S) RULED BY THE SULTAN (AUTHORITY).

SULTANATE (n)- LAND WHERE SULTAN CLAIMS ALMOST-FULL SOVEREIGNTY WITHOUT CLAIMING THE OVERALL CALIPHATE; ALSO, THE TITLE OF A GOVERNOR OF A PORTION OF THE CALIPHATE

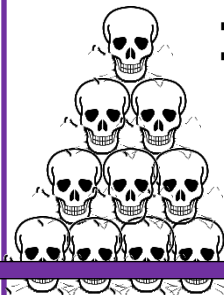

- RULER OF FORMER MONGOL KHANATE
 - CHAGATAI KHANATE/ MOGULISTAN
 - **CAPITAL:** SAMARKAND (UZBEKISTAN)
 - DESCENDENT OF ORIGINAL MONGOL TRIBE
 - CONQUERED:
 - CENTRAL ASIA (CHAGATAI KHANATE)
 - PERSIA (ILKHANATE)
 - GEORGIA (GOLDEN HORDE)
 - INDIA (DELHI SULTANATE)
 - DESTROYED THE CITY OF DELHI
 - AFTER DEATH → POWER WANED (CIVIL WARS)
 - SAFAVIDS TOOK BACK PERSIA
 - MUGHALS TOOK BACK INDIA



WHEN HE CONQUERED PERSIA (ISFAHAN). HE PROCEEDED TO EXECUTE 100,000 & BUILT 28 TOWERS OF SKULLS WITH 1500 SKULLS EACH!



TAMERLANE'S BODY WAS EXHUMED BY SOVIET ANTHROPOLOGISTS IN 1941. FROM HIS REMAINS, THEY WERE ABLE TO RECREATE HIS FACIAL FEATURES. THEY ALSO CONFIRMED HIS HIP INJURY LEADING TO HIS NAME. THE INSCRIPTION ON HIS TOMB READ, "WHEN I RISE FROM THE DEAD THE WORLD WILL TREMBLE." UPON OPENING HIS TOMB ANOTHER INSCRIPTION WAS FOUND, "WHOEVER OPENS MY TOMB SHALL UNLEASH AN INVADER MORE TERRIBLE THAN I". TWO DAYS LATER, HITLER INVADED THE USSR.

- PUNJAB, INDIA IS THE ONLY MAJORITY SIKH REGION ON EARTH
- FOUNDED BY GURU NANAK IN PUNJAB CIRCA 1500

BELIEFS:

- MONOTHEISM; SAME GOD FOR ALL RELIGIONS
- CONDEMNS "BLIND" RITUAL, PILGRIMAGE, ETC.
- ALL ARE EQUAL IN GOD'S EYES (RACE/GENDER)
- WOMEN PARTICIPATE IN ALL RITUALS
- COMBINATION OF ISLAM/HINDU
- "THERE IS NO ISLAM. THERE IS NO HINDU."

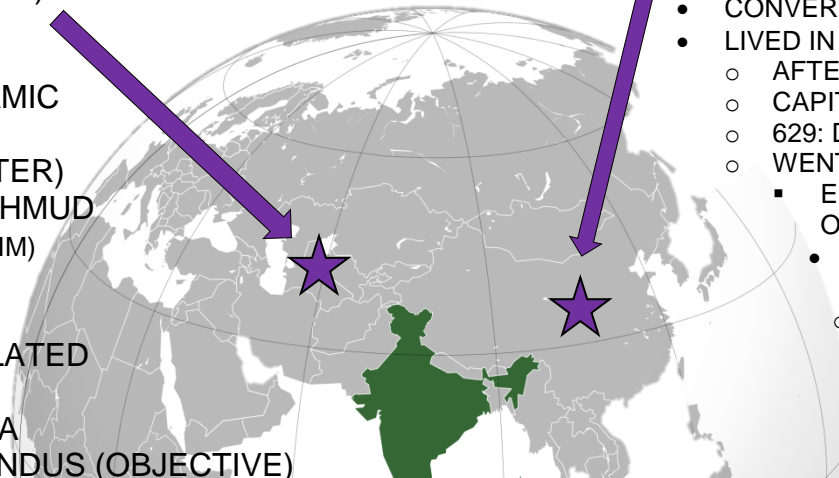

- FROM KHWARIZM (UZBEKISTAN)
- PERSIAN POLYMATH
- GREATEST INTERPRETER OF INDIAN SCIENCE TO THE ISLAMIC WORLD
- KNOWN AS AL-USTADH (MASTER)
- COURT ASTRONOMER OF MAHMUD OF GHAZNI (INVADED WITH HIM)



- IDEAS:
 - HELIOCENTRIC
 - HUMANS ALL RELATED
 - WROTE HISTORY OF INDIA ACCEPTED BY HINDUS (OBJECTIVE)

FROM LUOYANG, HENAN (CHINA) (602-664)

- BORN INTO CONFUCIANIST FAMILY
- CONVERTED TO BUDDHISM
- LIVED IN MONASTERY WITH BROTHER
 - AFTER SUI FELL, MOVED TO CHANGAN
 - CAPITAL OF TANG CHINA
 - 629: DREAMED OF VISITING INDIA
 - WENT STUPA TO STUPA
 - ENCOUNTERED MANY THOUSANDS OF MONKS
 - VISITED MAJOR SITES IN BUDDHA'S LIFE
 - (LIKE A BUDDHIST HAJJ)
 - BROUGHT BACK 1000s OF BUDDHIST TEXTS/RELICS
 - RETURNED IN 645
 - WROTE *JOURNEY TO THE WEST**
